Before School Care Program

(Available for Twos, Threes, Fours, and Bridging Kindergarten)

Before school care begins at 7:45 am and is staffed by GSES teachers. Children may be brought to the Bridging Kindergarten Room and sign in with the teachers on duty. They will have quiet activities, books, and puzzles to occupy themselves until they are released to their regular classroom at 8:45 am. Charges for Before School Care are by membership according to the number of days a child will be dropped off early each week.

All students enrolled in Before School Care must be potty-trained.

Pre-registration is preferred for us to staff accordingly and maintain an ideal student/teacher ratio. A drop-in charge of \$25.00 per day will be billed for children who are not pre-registered.

After School Enrichment Program (ASEP)

(Available for Threes, Fours, and Bridging Kindergarten)

Class descriptions, fees, times and age limits are described below. For your convenience, children enrolled in an ASEP class are automatically enrolled in Stay and Play for that day as a "bridge" if the ASEP class begins at a later time (Stay and Play fees will apply.)

Amazing Animals (Threes)

Amazing Animals is an introduction to weird and wonderful animals from around the world. Through books and hands-on activities, students will explore extraordinary animals and their habitats. From mammals that lay eggs to fish that fly, children will be amazed by the wonders of the animal world!

This class is taught by Jennifer Mohn, who is a former GSES teacher. Mrs. Mohn is excited to go on this wild animal adventure!



Stay and Play (Threes and Fours)

This class is a peaceful, unstructured afternoon hour for all children to attend on the days that they are enrolled at Good Shepherd Episcopal School. It is directed and staffed by our own teachers. It is a time for the children to play together after a busy day at school and a time of flexibility for those attending After School Enrichment Programs.

The following information will prepare you and your child for attendance in Stay and Play:

- Please send a complete change of clothes (socks included) in the child's backpack on the days they attend Stay and Play. This is in addition to clothes that are sent to be kept in the classroom for the morning program.
- Dismissal for students attending Stay and Play will take place as part of the regular dismissal of all classes.
- A fee of \$20 will be assessed for late pick-up (after 10 minutes late).
- As the year begins, keep in mind that your child's adjustment in the school program is of primary importance. Please consult with your child's teacher about whether participation in any extended program is appropriate.
